Article XVI Section 1 as follows:

Section 1. These Bylaws may be amended by majority vote of the REALTOR® Members present and qualified to vote at any meeting at which a quorum is present, provided the substances of such proposed amendment or amendments shall be plainly stated in an electronic notice provided to all members. Electronic voting of Bylaw changes will begin 2 business days prior to the day of the duly noticed meeting as outlined in Section 2. Electronic voting will close after the first 30 minutes of the meeting. Once voting has been called by the members present at the meeting, the in-person votes will be tallied and added to the electronic votes for a final total. The results will be shown to the membership at the meeting for affirmation. the call for the meeting. When Bylaws amendments are mandated by NAR policy, these Bylaws may be automatically amended to reflect the mandate as of the effective date of the mandatory policy authorized by the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS[®]. The Board shall provide notice of that change in a regular or special membership communication.
